Wishing you a very fruitful conference!

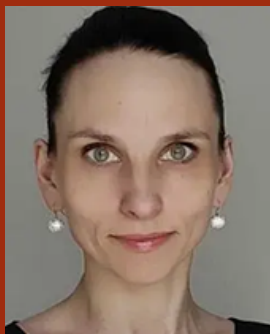

Note:

If you need a phone card, your phone must have a SIM card slot and be a full netcom phone.

The Internet in China is much different from the one in every other country. Using Google is almost impossible. Logging into Facebook or checking e-mail on Gmail is also quite problematic. Therefore We recommend to downloading VPN (Virtual Private Network) before arriving in China.

VPN needs to be downloaded before landing in China, as the installation is impossible in the country.
